### BECOME A DELEGATION LEADER

### 2026 Spring and Summer International Youth Exchanges

**Interested former or current educators** are invited to apply to become a Delegation Leader to one of Fort Worth's sister cities around the globe for spring or summer exchanges. If you have the interest and the commitment to provide a global education for students, you can experience a memorable visit to one of the cities listed below. Expenses for travel are provided except for a \$500 program fee, host family gifts, luggage costs, some meals, and miscellaneous costs. Travel arrangements are made by Sister Cities in collaboration with our international colleagues. All leaders and youth stay with host families and for some exchanges, one night in a youth hostel.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- ◆ Supervise 8-20 middle and/or high school students to Indonesia, France, Hungary, Italy, Germany or Japan and provide a memorable and educational experience.
- ◆ Recruit five students to apply for an exchange. If your students are selected, your \$500 program fee will be refunded.
- ◆ Coordinate trainings to prepare the students. Spring exchanges meet twice a month, and summer meet monthly.
- ◆ Must be available for student interviews to select Youth Ambassadors Nov. 3–9. *(dates depend on number of applicants).* Mandatory attendance at Dec. 7 pre-travel orientation with selected students and their parents or guardians.
- ◆ Harashin teachers will work with Sister Cities to plan and implement the local program for inbound Nagaoka students in July. Must be available to host Nagaoka teacher and participate in all activities during their visit to Fort Worth (approx. July 17-25).

#### REGGIO EMILIA, ITALY: March 14–22, 2026

Reggio Emilia is a scenic and historic city. Visit historical sites including cathedrals and palazzos dating back to the 12th century.



#### NIMES, FRANCE: March 14–22, 2026

Nimes is a scenic and historic city. Visit historical sites including ancient ruins and see why it is called the "French Rome."



#### BUDAPEST, HUNGARY: March 14–22, 2026

Experience 2000 years of history in a city reborn several times from pre-Roman to post Iron curtain as you journey through time.



#### NAGAOKA, JAPAN: June 16–24, 2026

Nagaoka is a city of tranquility rich in history. Live with a host family, visit local sites, and enjoy a day excursion to the Sea of Japan.



#### TRIER, GERMANY: June 3–11, 2026

Explore archeological areas of Germany's oldest city, Trier. The group will visit medieval markets, theaters, museums, and palaces.
