Global Leaders in Action will encourage students to explore how they see other cultures and understand global influences while using youth leadership skills to promote peace through service to their communities. Global Leaders will collaborate with one another to design and implement leadership and cultural training for younger students in the Fort Worth community and visit various local nonprofits to experience community-enhancing leadership. They will also gain essential leadership and communication skills through cross-cultural activities such as art, music, and language studies to make their communities a more peaceful place.

Global Leaders in Action is led by a team of highly qualified and experienced educators who, along with several international partners, have developed a highly interactive program. Local university students will facilitate group learning experiences as Global Leaders collaborate to learn, problem solve, and design and implement their own leadership and cultural competency trainings.

Tuition: \$950 USD total. \$100 non-refundable deposit due May 1. Tuition includes:
