Chris Dufour is an expert in disinformation and counterpropaganda, strategic influence, digital privacy and security, digital investigations, and open source intelligence. A master of learning and instructional design, Dufour has developed training for the U.S. Department of Defense, the Department of Justice, the Department of Homeland Security, Fortune 500 companies, and several Australian defense, intelligence, and law enforcement entities.
