DAY 1 FEB. 22

Depart on flight for Mexico City.

Arrive Mexico City and transfer by bus to Toluca.

Lunch at El Carnalito.

Check in to Fiesta Inn Toluca Centro.

DAY 2 FEB. 23

Both groups reunite at the breathtaking **Cosmovitral**, Toluca's crown jewel featuring one of the world's largest stained glass murals depicting the relationship between humans and the universe, housed in a stunning Art Nouveau botanical garden.

DAY 4 FEB. 25

Transfer to Mexico City.

Enjoy an exclusive behind-the-scenes tour of the **Legislative Palace of San Lázaro**, seat of Mexico's Chamber of Deputies, gaining insight into the country's democratic processes.

Explore the trendy neighborhoods of **Roma** and **Condesa**, known for their Art Deco architecture, vibrant café culture, and tree-lined streets that represent modern Mexican urban life.

Dinner at Terraza Cha Cha Cha.

Check in to Hotel Imperial Reforma.

DAY 5 FEB. 26

Visit **Casa Azul** in Coyoacán, the intimate former home of Frida Kahlo, now a museum showcasing her personal belongings, artwork, and the space where she created many of her most famous pieces. Explore charming **Coyoacán**'s cobblestone streets, colonial mansions, and vibrant markets in this bohemian neighborhood beloved by artists and intellectuals.



Lunch at Los Danzantes.

Conclude with **Polanco**, Mexico City's upscale district, and the striking **Museo Soumaya** with its honeycomb exterior housing an impressive collection including works by Rodin, Dalí, and Mexican masters.
